

# SENATE BILL No. 1294

May 7, 2002, Introduced by Senator SANBORN and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 288, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan work-study program for qualified resident students attending eligible postsecondary schools and employed by qualified employers; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 390.1373).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 3. A recognized postsecondary school in this state is  
2 eligible to participate in the MWS program if the postsecondary  
3 school is a degree-granting institution approved by the ~~state~~  
4 ~~board of education~~ DEPARTMENT OF CAREER DEVELOPMENT, the  
5 instructional programs are not comprised solely of sectarian  
6 instruction or religious worship, and the school participates in  
7 the federal work-study program under sections 441 to 448 of title  
8 IV of the higher education act of 1965, 42 U.S.C. 2751 to 2756b.

1 A participating school, at its option, may offer academic credit  
2 to students enrolled in the MWS program.
