Sec. 250. (1) All insurers licensed to do business in this 1 2 state shall notify the commissioner within 30 days of the 3 appointment or election of any new officers or directors, or any transfer of stock which THAT results in any one 1 person 4 holding 10% or more of the voting shares of an insurer. IN ADDI-5 TION, A DOMESTIC INSURER SHALL NOTIFY THE COMMISSIONER WITHIN 30 6 DAYS OF THE APPOINTMENT OR ELECTION OF ANY NEW OFFICERS OR 7 DIRECTORS. 8

9 (2) If, after proceedings under section 249, the
10 commissioner has reason to believe that an officer or director is
