<b>Analysis</b>	<p><b>Summary</b> HB 4137 encourages school boards to include instruction and programs concerning the dangers of tobacco use in their curriculum.</p> <p><b>Fiscal Impact</b> This bill would have no state fiscal impact. There is a potential minor local impact for districts that begin to include instruction and programs concerning the dangers of tobacco use due to this language. Some such potential costs might include those related to the development or purchase of curriculum and educational materials. The dollar amount of the impact to districts is indeterminate.</p>
