House Committee Regulatory Reform

Analysis **Summary**
The bill would amend the Michigan Liquor Control Code to provide for imprisonment for up to 90 days of a minor who purchased, consumed, or possessed alcoholic liquor. Imprisonment could not be ordered for a first offense unless the defendant had failed to complete court-ordered treatment or had failed to pay a fine.

Fiscal Impact
The bill could increase local jail costs.
