

SAGINAW COUNTY: REPEAL LOCAL ACTS

House Bills 5365 and 5366 Sponsor: Rep. Jim Howell Committee: Judiciary

A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 5365 AND 5366 AS INTRODUCED 12-10-03

<u>House Bill 5365</u> would repeal Local Act 653 of 1905, which requires that all officers, appointees, and servants elected by the board of supervisors of Saginaw County be elected by *viva voce* vote. (As regards voting, the term *viva voce*, according to Black's Law Dictionary, "signifies voting by speech or outcry as distinguished from voting by a written or printed ballot".)

<u>House Bill 5366</u> would repeal Local Act 540 of 1903, which established a board of county auditors for Saginaw County and prescribed its powers and duties and the nature of its operations.
