## SUBSTITUTE FOR

## HOUSE BILL NO. 6003

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law," by amending section 972 (MCL 168.972), as amended by 2003 PA

302.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 972. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a
candidate for a nonpartisan office shall be nominated and voted
for in an election scheduled under section 971 by filing a
nominating petition or paying a \$100.00 nonrefundable fee not
later than 4 p.m. on the fifteenth day after the <u>election is</u>
called clerk of the county where the petition was filed
announces the official result of the recall election. The clerk
shall publicly announce the result of the recall election at the
conclusion of the meeting held by the board of county canvassers
to certify the recall election. The nominating petition shall be

filed with the clerk of the electoral district and signed by a
 number of qualified and registered electors of the electoral
 district as determined under section 544f. Instead of filing a
 nominating petition, an individual may become a candidate by
 paying a \$100.00 nonrefundable fee with the clerk of the
 electoral district.

(2) This subsection applies to an election to fill a vacancy 7 for an unexpired term created by a recall of a school board 8 member, if the election is scheduled to be held on the same date 9 as a general election. A nominating petition filed by a 10 candidate shall be signed by a number of qualified and registered 11 12 electors of the school district as determined under section 13 -544f - 303. The nominating petition shall clearly state that it relates to the filling of a vacancy for an unexpired term and 14 shall be filed with the school district -filing official 15 election coordinator, as designated by section 301, not later 16 than 4 p.m. on the fifteenth day after the -election is called 17 clerk of the county where the petition was filed announces the 18 official result of the recall election. The clerk shall publicly 19 20 announce the result of the recall election at the conclusion of the meeting held by the board of county canvassers to certify the 21 recall election. Instead of filing a nominating petition, an 22 individual may become a candidate by paying a \$100.00 23 nonrefundable fee to the school district -filing official not 24 later than 4 p.m. on the fifteenth day after the election is 25 26 called election coordinator.
