# SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1349

### A bill to amend 1855 PA 105, entitled

"An act to regulate the disposition of the surplus funds in the state treasury; to provide for the deposit of surplus funds in certain financial institutions; to lend surplus funds pursuant to loan agreements secured by certain commercial, agricultural, or industrial real and personal property; to authorize the loan of surplus funds to certain municipalities; to authorize the participation in certain loan programs; to authorize an appropriation; and to prescribe the duties of certain state agencies,"

by amending section 2e (MCL 21.142e), as added by 2001 PA 123.

#### THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2e. (1) The state treasurer may loan not more than
- 2 \$5,000,000.00 in surplus funds, without interest, to sugar beet
- 3 growers' cooperatives for the purpose of purchasing the assets of
- 4 1 or more agricultural processors if all of the following
- 5 conditions are met:
- 6 (a) The agricultural processor employs at least 300 full-time
- 7 employees and 1,000 seasonal employees and is in bankruptcy

- 1 proceedings or was in bankruptcy proceedings at any time during
- 2 the 1-year period preceding the date of the loan.
- 3 (b) The loan amount does not exceed 10% of the total purchase
- 4 price of the agricultural processor's assets.
- 5 (c) The loan is for a period not to exceed 5 years.
- 6 (2) In addition to the conditions provided in subsection (1),
- 7 the state treasurer may prescribe additional terms of a loan
- 8 issued under this section.
- 9 (3) A sugar beet growers' cooperative that wishes to apply
- 10 for a loan under this section shall submit a loan application to
- 11 the state treasurer before January 1, 2002. In the case of a
- 12 loan executed under subsection (1), the state treasurer, as part
- 13 of the modification of the loan, <<may>> subordinate the loan to
- 14 the primary loan of the sugar beet growers' cooperative and shall
- 15 relinquish any enforcement powers or authority that may exist
- 16 under the current contract or agreement. The modification shall
- 17 be for not more than a \$5,000,000.00 loan to a sugar beet
- 18 growers' cooperative for the purpose of purchasing the assets of
- 19 1 or more agricultural processors that employ at least 300
- 20 full-time employees and 1,000 seasonal employees.
- 21 (4) As used in this section, "sugar beet growers'
- 22 cooperative" means a farmer owned cooperative comprised of sugar
- 23 beet growers who own the assets of the cooperative and use the
- 24 cooperative's services or processing equipment.
