THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 CHAPTER X

2 Sec. 2a. A motion to withdraw a plea of guilty or nolo 3 contendere is subject to all of the following:

- 4 (a) The motion shall be made within 1 year after the court 5 entered the plea on the record.
 - (b) A prosecuting attorney from any county in this state has standing to challenge the motion in the court in which the motion was filed if that prosecuting attorney has filed a charge against the person making the motion.
 - (c) The moving party shall notify the prosecuting attorney in each county in which the person was convicted of or is charged
