THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 8. A public body may meet in a closed session only for
- 2 the following purposes:

- 3 (a) To consider the dismissal, suspension, or disciplining
 - of, or to hear complaints or charges brought against, or to
 - consider a periodic personnel evaluation of, a public officer,
 - employee, staff member, or individual agent, if the named person

- 1 (b) To consider the dismissal, suspension, or disciplining of
