- 1 Sec. 224. The term of office of a board member shall be 3
- 2 years from April 1 of the year of appointment, except that of the

- 4 year, 4 for 2 years, and 4 for 3 years. A vacancy shall be
- 5 filled for an unexpired term in the same manner as an original
- 6 appointment. A board member may be removed from office by the

- 8 appointed by the chief executive officer of a county or a city
- 9 under section 216, by the -chief executive officer individual

- 1 misconduct in office after being given a written statement of
- 2 reasons and an opportunity to be heard on the removal. A board
- 3 member shall be paid a per diem no larger than the highest per
- 4 diem for members of other county advisory boards set by the
- 5 county board of commissioners and be reimbursed for necessary
- 6 travel expenses for each meeting attended. The mileage expense
- 7 fixed by the county board of commissioners shall not exceed the
- 8 mileage reimbursement as determined by the state officers
- 9 compensation commission. A board member shall not receive more
- 10 than 1 per diem payment per day regardless of the number of
