

SENATE BILL No. 1166

April 22, 2004, Introduced by Senators CHERRY, SCHAUER, BRATER, LELAND and OLSHOVE and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled "The code of criminal procedure," by amending section 11d of chapter XVII (MCL 777.11d), as added by 2002 PA 31.
