## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 211

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 41301 (MCL 324.41301), as added by 2003 PA 270.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 41301. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (A) "COUNCIL" MEANS THE INVASIVE SPECIES ADVISORY COUNCIL
- 3 CREATED IN SECTION 41321.
- 4 (B) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.
- 5 (C)  $\frac{-(a)}{(a)}$  "Genetically engineered" refers to  $\frac{-a \text{ fish}}{(a)}$  AN
- 6 ORGANISM whose genome, chromosomal or extrachromosomal, is modified
- 7 permanently and heritably, using recombinant nucleic acid
- 8 techniques, or the progeny thereof.

- 1 (D) "INTRODUCE", WITH REFERENCE TO AN ORGANISM, MEANS TO
- 2 KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY STOCK, PLACE, PLANT, RELEASE, OR ALLOW THE
- 3 RELEASE OF THE ORGANISM IN THIS STATE AT ANY SPECIFIC LOCATION
- 4 WHERE THE ORGANISM IS NOT ALREADY NATURALIZED.
- 5 (E) "PROHIBITED AQUATIC PLANT SPECIES" MEANS ANY OF THE
- 6 FOLLOWING OR FRAGMENTS OR SEEDS THEREOF:
- 7 (i) AFRICAN OXYGEN WEED (LAGAROSIPHON MAJOR) OR A HYBRID OR
- 8 GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT THEREOF.
- 9 (ii) BRAZILIAN ELODEA (EGERIA DENSA) OR A HYBRID OR GENETICALLY
- 10 ENGINEERED VARIANT THEREOF.
- 11 (iii) EUROPEAN FROGBIT (HYDROCHARIS MORSUS-RANAE) OR A HYBRID OR
- 12 GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT THEREOF.
- 13 (iv) GIANT HOGWEED (HERACLEUM MANTEGAZZIANUM) OR A HYBRID OR

- 2 (F) —(b) "Prohibited FISH species" means any of the following

- 6 (ii) Bitterling (Rhodeus sericeus) or a hybrid or genetically
- 7 engineered variant thereof.
- 8 (iii) Black carp (Mylopharyngodon piceus) or a hybrid or

- 10 (iv) Grass carp (Ctenopharyngodon idellus) or a hybrid or

- 3 (H) "PROHIBITED SPECIES" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 6 (iii) A PROHIBITED INSECT SPECIES.
- 7 (I) —(e) "Recombinant nucleic acid techniques" means
- 8 laboratory techniques through which genetic material is isolated
- 9 and manipulated in vitro and then inserted into an organism.
- 10 (J) "RESTRICTED AQUATIC PLANT SPECIES" MEANS ANY OF THE
- 11 FOLLOWING OR FRAGMENTS OR SEEDS THEREOF:
- 12 (i) CURLY LEAF PONDWEED (POTAMOGETON CRISPUS) OR A HYBRID OR
- 13 GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT THEREOF.
- 14 (ii) EURASIAN WATERMILFOIL (MYRIOPHYLLUM SPICATUM) OR A HYBRID
- 15 OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT THEREOF.
- 16 (iii) FLOWERING RUSH (BUTOMUS UMBELLATUS) OR A HYBRID OR
- 17 GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT THEREOF.
- 18 (iv) PHRAGMITES OR COMMON REED (PHRAGMITES AUSTRALIS) OR A
- 19 HYBRID OR GENETICALLY ENGINEERED VARIANT THEREOF.
- 20 (v) PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE (LYTHRUM SALICARIA) OR A HYBRID OR

- 25 (K) "RESTRICTED SPECIES" MEANS A RESTRICTED AQUATIC PLANT
- 26 SPECIES.
- 27 (2) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS PART:

- 1 (A) A PERSON IS NOT CONSIDERED TO POSSESS A LIVE ORGANISM
- 2 SIMPLY BECAUSE THE ORGANISM IS PRESENT ON LAND OR IN WATERS OWNED
- 3 BY THAT PERSON UNLESS THE PERSON HAS KNOWINGLY INTRODUCED THAT LIVE
- 4 ORGANISM ON THAT LAND OR IN THOSE WATERS.
- 5 (B) A PERSON IS NOT CONSIDERED TO POSSESS A LIVE ORGANISM IF
- 6 THE ORGANISM WAS OBTAINED FROM THE ENVIRONMENT AND THE PERSON ONLY
- 7 POSSESSES THE ORGANISM AT THE SPECIFIC LOCATION AT WHICH IT WAS
- 8 OBTAINED FROM THE ENVIRONMENT.
- 9 (C) A PERSON IS NOT CONSIDERED TO POSSESS A LIVE ORGANISM IF
- 10 THE POSSESSION IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMPTLY DESTROYING THE
- 11 ORGANISM.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
