SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 5306

A bill to amend 1986 PA 273, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan educational opportunity grant program for resident qualified students enrolled in eligible public postsecondary schools; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

by amending section 4 (MCL 390.1404).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) A student is eligible to participate in the MEOG
- 2 program under this act if the student meets the following
- 3 requirements:
- 4 (a) Has resided in this state continuously for the 12 months
- 5 preceding his or her application for a MEOG and is not considered a
- 6 resident of any other state.
- 7 (b) Is not incarcerated in a corrections institute.

- 1 (c) Is enrolled in at least a half-time undergraduate program
- 2 of study at a postsecondary school that meets the requirements of
- 3 section 3.
- 4 (d) Is certified by the financial aid officer at the
- 5 postsecondary school as needing the grant in order to meet
- 6 recognized educational expenses.
- 7 (e) Is a United States citizen or permanent resident.
- 8 (E) IS A UNITED STATES CITIZEN OR ANY OTHER STUDENT DESCRIBED
- 9 AS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE TITLE IV, HEA PROGRAM ASSISTANCE UNDER 34
- 10 CFR 668.33.
- 11 (f) Is not in default on a loan guaranteed by the authority.
- 12 (2) A student shall maintain satisfactory academic progress,
- 13 as defined by the postsecondary school in which the student is
- 14 enrolled, to remain eligible for a MEOG under this act.
- 15 (3) A student shall not be eligible for a MEOG for more than
- 16 10 semesters of undergraduate education, or its equivalent in
- 17 trimesters or quarters, or the equivalent as determined by the
- 18 authority for less than full-time students.
- 19 (4) If a student possessing a degree at a given academic level
- 20 enrolls for a second degree at the same or lower academic level,
- 21 the authority shall include MEOGs received by the student when he
- 22 or she was enrolled for the previous degree at the same or lower
- 23 level in determining the student's eligibility under this act.
- 24 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 25 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
