

SUBSTITUTE FOR
SENATE BILL NO. 1171

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
by amending section 168 (MCL 750.168).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 168. (1) ~~Any~~ EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), A
2 person convicted of being a disorderly person ~~shall be~~ IS guilty
3 of a misdemeanor PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90
4 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

5 (2) A PERSON CONVICTED OF BEING A DISORDERLY PERSON UNDER
6 SECTION 167D IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE AS FOLLOWS:

7 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (B), BY IMPRISONMENT FOR
8 NOT MORE THAN 2 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR
9 BOTH.

10 (B) IF THE PERSON WAS PREVIOUSLY CONVICTED OF VIOLATING
11 SECTION 167D, BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 4 YEARS OR A FINE

1 **OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.**

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
3 after the date it is enacted.

4 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
5 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
6 enacted into law:
