

HOUSE BILL No. 4208

February 3, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Stakoe and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Policy.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 217, entitled
"Electrical administrative act,"
by amending section 7a (MCL 338.887a), as added by 1990 PA 246.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 7a. (1) A governmental subdivision shall appoint as an
2 inspector an individual who shall be licensed as an electrical
3 journeyman or master electrician.

4 (2) An ~~electrical~~ inspector may request that a person licensed
5 under this act produce the identification card described in section
6 8c and not less than 1 piece of identification containing the
7 individual's picture.

8 (3) An inspector shall register under **AND COMPLY WITH** the

3 (4) AN INSPECTOR SHALL NOT ENGAGE IN ACTIVITIES CONSIDERED TO

7 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISION" MEANS
8 THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2A OF THE STILLE-DEROSSETT-HALE
9 SINGLE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1502A.
