HOUSE BILL No. 4260

February 10, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Hune, Gaffney, Stewart, Emmons and Nitz and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1951 PA 90, entitled

"An act to regulate the conducting of racing meets in the state of Michigan; to provide for the possession, control and disposition of funds held by licensees for the payment of outstanding winning tickets not claimed or demanded by the lawful owners of such funds; and to prescribe penalties for violations of the provisions of this act,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 431.252), as amended by 1998 PA 505.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) For the calendar year 1998 and each year
- 2 thereafter, all funds ALL MONEY held by any licensee for the
- 3 payment of outstanding winning tickets OR VOUCHERS for any race
- 4 meeting conducted under the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA 279,
- 5 MCL 431.301 to 431.336, which have THAT HAS not been claimed by the
- 6 owner of those funds THE MONEY within 60 days after the close of
 - the race meeting, shall be retained by the licensee and distributed

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- 1 as follows:
- 2 (a) If the licensee is a standardbred race meeting licensee:
- 3 (A) (i)— Fifty percent of the funds shall be retained by the
- 4 licensee.
- 5 (B) (ii) Fifty percent of the funds shall be deposited into
- 6 the Michigan agriculture equine fund created in section 20(3) of
- 7 the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA 279, MCL 431.320, and
- 8 designated for standardbred programs described in section 20(5)(a),
- 9 (c), (e), (h), and (i) of the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA
- 10 279, MCL 431.320. DISTRIBUTED TO THE CERTIFIED HORSEMEN'S
- 11 ORGANIZATION WITH WHICH THE LICENSEE HAS A CONTRACT. THE CERTIFIED
- 12 HORSEMEN'S ORGANIZATION MAY EXPEND THE MONEY RECEIVED UNDER THIS
- 13 SUBDIVISION ONLY FOR ANY REASONABLE PURPOSE RELATED TO THE
- 14 MANAGEMENT, PROTECTION, AND PROMOTION OF LIVE HORSE RACING IN THIS
- 15 STATE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PURSE SUPPLEMENTS, PROMOTION,
- 16 BENEVOLENCE, OFFICE AND ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE, PROFESSIONAL FEES,
- 17 BACKSIDE WELFARE, EMPLOYEE WELFARE, AND INSURANCE PROGRAMS.
- 18 (b) If the licensee is a thoroughbred race meeting licensee,
- 19 then 100% of the funds for 1998 shall be earmarked for the
- 20 development and capital improvement for the purpose of
- 21 accommodating thoroughbred racing at existing licensed racing
- 22 facilities that have operated within the 2 years immediately before
- 23 the effective date of the amendatory act that added this
- 24 subdivision within a city area or at a facility located outside a
- 25 city area upon written approval of a certified thoroughbred
- 26 horsemen's organization and approved by the racing commissioner. As
- 27 used in this subdivision, "city area" and "horsemen's organization"

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- 1 mean those terms as defined in section 2 of the horse racing law of
- 2 1995, 1995 PA 279, MCL 431.302. For calendar year 1999 and every
- 3 year thereafter:
- 4 (i) Fifty percent of the funds shall be retained by the
- 5 licensee.
- 6 (ii) Fifty percent of the funds shall be deposited in the
- 7 Michigan agriculture equine fund established in section 20(3) of
- 8 the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA 279, MCL 431.320, and
- 9 designated for thoroughbred programs described in section 20(6)(a)
- 10 to (e) of the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA 279, MCL 431.320.
- 11 (c) If the licensee is a light horse race meeting licensee:
- 13 licensee.
- 14 (ii) Fifty percent of the funds shall be deposited in the
- 15 Michigan agriculture equine fund established in section 20(3) of
- 16 the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA 279, MCL 431.320, and
- 17 designated for light horse programs described in section 20(7),
- 18 (8), and (9) of the horse racing law of 1995, 1995 PA 279, MCL
- **19** 431.320.
- 20 (d) Funds for uncashed tickets for calendar year 1998 held by
- 21 the department of treasury that were remitted by licensees shall be
- 22 distributed as provided in this section.
- 23 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 24 (A) "CERTIFIED HORSEMEN'S ORGANIZATION" MEANS THAT TERM AS
- 25 DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE HORSE RACING LAW OF 1995, 1995 PA 279,
- 26 MCL 431.302.
- 27 (B) "LICENSEE" MEANS A PERSON THAT HOLDS A RACE MEETING

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- 1 LICENSE AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 8 OF THE HORSE RACING LAW OF 1995,
