

HOUSE BILL No. 4726

May 3, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Mortimer and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1177a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1177A. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
2 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ENSURE THAT EACH PUBLIC
3 SCHOOL IT OPERATES PROVIDES INFORMATION TO PARENTS AND GUARDIANS
4 ABOUT MENINGOCOCCAL MENINGITIS AND THE VACCINE FOR MENINGOCOCCAL
5 MENINGITIS AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR. THE INFORMATION
6 SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST THE CAUSES AND SYMPTOMS OF MENINGOCOCCAL
7 MENINGITIS, HOW IT IS SPREAD, AND SOURCES WHERE PARENTS AND
8 GUARDIANS MAY OBTAIN ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT MENINGOCOCCAL
9 MENINGITIS AND MAY OBTAIN VACCINATION OF A CHILD AGAINST

1 MENINGOCOCCAL MENINGITIS.

2 (2) THE DEPARTMENT, IN COOPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
3 COMMUNITY HEALTH, SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL
4 DISTRICTS, PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES, NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS, AND HOME
5 SCHOOLS INFORMATION THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1).
