A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 168a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 168A. (1) A PERSON WHO ENTERS ONTO THE PROPERTY OF
- 2 ANOTHER PERSON TO WINDOW-PEEP IN VIOLATION OF SECTION 167 OR A
- 3 LOCAL ORDINANCE SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO SECTION 167 IS
- 4 GUILTY OF A CRIME AS FOLLOWS:
- 5 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (B), THE PERSON IS
 6 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE
 7 THAN 93 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
 - (B) IF THE PERSON WAS PREVIOUSLY CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THIS SECTION, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
