

# HOUSE BILL No. 4753

May 10, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Meisner, Byrum, Sak, Bieda, Rocca, Miller, Vagnozzi, Zelenko, Hopgood and Garfield and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 168a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 168A. (1) A PERSON WHO ENTERS ONTO THE PROPERTY OF  
2        ANOTHER PERSON TO WINDOW-PEEP IN VIOLATION OF SECTION 167 OR A  
3        LOCAL ORDINANCE SUBSTANTIALLY CORRESPONDING TO SECTION 167 IS  
4        GUILTY OF A CRIME AS FOLLOWS:

5        (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBDIVISION (B), THE PERSON IS  
6        GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE  
7        THAN 93 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

8        (B) IF THE PERSON WAS PREVIOUSLY CONVICTED OF VIOLATING THIS  
9        SECTION, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY  
10       IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN

1 \$1,000.00, OR BOTH.

2 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE PERSON FROM BEING  
3 CHARGED WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR PUNISHED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF  
4 LAW COMMITTED BY THE PERSON WHILE VIOLATING OR ATTEMPTING TO  
5 VIOLATE THIS SECTION.
