HOUSE BILL No. 4754

May 10, 2005, Introduced by Reps. Kolb, Byrnes, Lipsey and Tobocman and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Great Lakes, Land Use, and Environment.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 17211.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- SEC. 17211. (1) A PERSON WHO IS IN THE BUSINESS OF RECYCLING
 APPLIANCES SHALL NOT RECYCLE OR PLACE INTO THE WASTE STREAM AN
 APPLIANCE OR A COMPONENT OF AN APPLIANCE UNLESS THE PERSON HAS
- 4 RECEIVED TRAINING IN IDENTIFYING, REMOVING, AND RECYCLING MERCURY5 ADDED PRODUCTS THAT ARE COMPONENTS OF APPLIANCES.
 - (2) A PERSON WHO IS IN THE BUSINESS OF RECYCLING APPLIANCES
 SHALL NOT RECYCLE OR PLACE INTO THE WASTE STREAM AN APPLIANCE OR A
 COMPONENT OF AN APPLIANCE THAT IS A MERCURY-ADDED PRODUCT UNLESS
