A bill to amend 1994 PA 295, entitled

"Sex offenders registration act,"

(MCL 28.721 to 28.732) by amending the title, as amended by 2004 PA 237, and by adding section 4b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

An act to require persons convicted of certain offenses to register; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain departments and agencies in connection with that registration; TO IMPOSE DUTIES ON CERTAIN PERSONS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED; and to prescribe fees, penalties, and sanctions.

SEC. 4B. (1) A PERSON WHO IS AN EMPLOYER OR EMPLOYED IN A

- 14 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A
- 15 STATE CIVIL INFRACTION AND MAY BE ORDERED TO PAY A CIVIL FINE OF
- 16 NOT LESS THAN \$500.00 AND NOT MORE THAN \$2,500.00.
