September 6, 2005, Introduced by Rep. Bieda and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Great Lakes, Land Use, and Environment.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding part 175.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 PART 175. CELL PHONE RECYCLING
- 2 SEC. 17501. AS USED IN THIS PART:
- 3 (A) "CELL PHONE" MEANS A WIRELESS TELEPHONE DEVICE THAT IS
- 4 DESIGNED TO SEND OR RECEIVE TRANSMISSIONS THROUGH A CELLULAR
- 5 RADIOTELEPHONE SERVICE, INCLUDING A RECHARGEABLE BATTERY CONNECTED
 - TO THE DEVICE. CELL PHONE DOES NOT INCLUDE A WIRELESS TELEPHONE
 - DEVICE THAT IS INTEGRATED INTO THE ELECTRICAL ARCHITECTURE OF A
- 8 MOTOR VEHICLE.

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- 1 (B) "CELLULAR RADIOTELEPHONE SERVICE" MEANS THAT TERM AS
- 2 DEFINED IN 47 CFR 22.99.
- 3 (C) "CONSUMER" MEANS A PERSON WHO IS THE PURCHASER OR OWNER OF
- 4 A CELL PHONE. CONSUMER DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSON INVOLVED IN A
- 5 WHOLESALE TRANSACTION BETWEEN A DISTRIBUTOR AND A RETAILER.
- 6 (D) "DISTRIBUTOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO SELLS A CELL PHONE TO A
- 7 RETAILER.
- 8 (E) "RETAILER" MEANS A PERSON WHO SELLS A CELL PHONE IN THIS
- 9 STATE TO A CONSUMER, INCLUDING A MANUFACTURER OF A CELL PHONE WHO
- 10 SELLS THE CELL PHONE DIRECTLY TO A CONSUMER.
- 11 (F) "SELL" MEANS TO TRANSFER, FOR CONSIDERATION, OWNERSHIP OR
- 12 THE RIGHT TO USE, BY LEASE OR SALES CONTRACT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 13 LIMITED TO, A TRANSFER MADE THROUGH A SALES OUTLET, CATALOG, OR THE
- 14 INTERNET OR ANY OTHER, SIMILAR ELECTRONIC MEANS. SELL DOES NOT
- 15 INCLUDE A TRANSFER THAT IS A WHOLESALE TRANSACTION WITH A
- 16 DISTRIBUTOR OR A RETAILER.
- 17 (G) "USED CELL PHONE" MEANS A CELL PHONE THAT HAS BEEN
- 18 PREVIOUSLY USED AND IS MADE AVAILABLE, BY A CONSUMER, FOR REUSE,
- 19 RECYCLING, OR PROPER DISPOSAL.
- 20 SEC. 17503. (1) BEGINNING JULY 1, 2006, A RETAILER THAT SELLS
- 21 CELL PHONES IN THIS STATE SHALL HAVE IN PLACE A SYSTEM TO RECEIVE
- 22 AND COLLECT USED CELL PHONES FOR REUSE, RECYCLING, OR PROPER
- 23 DISPOSAL THAT MEETS THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (2).
- 24 (2) A SYSTEM TO RECEIVE AND COLLECT USED CELL PHONES FOR
- 25 REUSE, RECYCLING, OR PROPER DISPOSAL SHALL, AT A MINIMUM, INCLUDE
- 26 ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ELEMENTS:
- 27 (A) ACCEPTANCE FROM A CONSUMER OF A USED CELL PHONE THAT THE

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- 1 RETAILER SOLD TO THE CONSUMER, AT NO COST TO THE CONSUMER. THE
- 2 RETAILER MAY REQUIRE PROOF THAT THE CELL PHONE WAS SOLD BY THE
- 3 RETAILER.
- 4 (B) ACCEPTANCE OF A USED CELL PHONE FROM A CONSUMER WHO IS
- 5 PURCHASING A NEW CELL PHONE FROM THE RETAILER, AT NO COST TO THE
- 6 CONSUMER.
- 7 (C) IF THE RETAILER DELIVERS A CELL PHONE DIRECTLY TO A
- 8 CONSUMER IN THIS STATE, A MECHANISM FOR THE CONSUMER, AT THE TIME
- 9 OF DELIVERY, TO SEND A USED CELL PHONE TO THE RETAILER, AT NO COST
- 10 TO THE CONSUMER.
- 11 (D) A METHOD TO MAKE INFORMATION AVAILABLE TO CONSUMERS ABOUT
- 12 CELL PHONE RECYCLING PROVIDED BY THE RETAILER AND TO ENCOURAGE
- 13 CONSUMERS TO MAKE USE OF THAT RECYCLING. THE METHOD MAY INCLUDE,
- 14 BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 15 (i) SIGNS PROMINENTLY DISPLAYED AND EASILY VISIBLE TO
- 16 CONSUMERS.
- 17 (ii) WRITTEN MATERIALS PROVIDED TO CONSUMERS AT THE TIME OF
- 18 PURCHASE OR DELIVERY.
- 19 (iii) REFERENCE TO THE CELL PHONE RECYCLING IN ADVERTISING OR
- 20 PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS.
- 21 (iv) DIRECT COMMUNICATIONS WITH THE CONSUMER AT THE TIME OF
- 22 PURCHASE.
- 23 (3) SUBSECTION (2)(D) DOES NOT APPLY TO A RETAILER THAT ONLY
- 24 SELLS PREPAID CELL PHONES AND DOES NOT OFFER A CONSUMER THE ABILITY
- 25 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR CELL PHONE SERVICE.
- 26 SEC. 17505. BEGINNING JULY 1, 2006, A RETAILER SHALL NOT SELL
- 27 A CELL PHONE TO A CONSUMER IN THIS STATE UNLESS THE RETAILER OF THE

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1 CELL PHONE COMPLIES WITH THIS PART.
