A bill to amend 1915 PA 31, entitled

"Youth tobacco act,"

by amending the title and sections 1, 2, and 4 (MCL 722.641, 722.642, and 722.644), the title and section 4 as amended by 1992 PA 272 and sections 1 and 2 as amended by 1988 PA 314.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 TITLE

An act to prohibit the selling, giving, or furnishing of tobacco products to minors; to prohibit the PURCHASE, POSSESSION,

OR use of tobacco products by minors; to prohibit the harboring of minors for the purpose of indulging in the use of tobacco products; to regulate the retail sale of tobacco products; to prescribe penalties; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state

- 1 agencies and departments.
- 2 Sec. 1. (1) A person shall not sell, give, or furnish any
- 3 cigarette, cigar, chewing tobacco, tobacco snuff, or tobacco in any
- 4 other form A TOBACCO PRODUCT to a person under 18 years of age
- 5 MINOR. A person who violates this -section SUBSECTION is guilty of
- 6 a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than \$50.00 for
- 7 each <u>offense</u> VIOLATION.
- 8 (2) Beginning 90 days after the effective date of this
- 9 subsection, a A person who sells tobacco products at retail shall
- 10 post, in a place close to the point of sale and conspicuous to both
- 11 employees and customers, a sign produced by the department of
- 12 public COMMUNITY health that includes the following statement:
- "The purchase of tobacco products by a minor under 18 years of
- 14 age and the provision of tobacco products to a minor are prohibited
- 15 by law. A minor unlawfully purchasing or using tobacco products is
- 16 subject to criminal penalties.".
- 17 (3) If the sign required under subsection (2) is more than 6
- 18 feet from the point of sale, it shall be 5-1/2 inches by 8-1/2
- 19 inches —, and the statement required under subsection (2) shall be
- 20 printed in 36-point -boldface- BOLDFACED type. If the sign required
- 21 under subsection (2) is 6 feet or less from the point of sale, it
- 22 shall be 2 inches by 4 inches $\frac{1}{2}$ and the statement required under
- 23 subsection (2) shall be printed in 20-point -boldface- BOLDFACED

- 25 (4) The department of public **COMMUNITY** health shall produce
- 26 the sign required under subsection (2) and have adequate copies of
- 27 the sign ready for distribution to licensed wholesalers, secondary

- 1 wholesalers, and unclassified acquirers of -cigarettes and other
- 2 tobacco products -described in subsection (1) free of charge.
- 3 within 60 days after the effective date of this subsection.
- 4 Licensed wholesalers, secondary wholesalers, and unclassified
- 5 acquirers of -cigarettes and other tobacco products -described in
- 6 subsection (1) shall obtain copies of the sign from the department
- 7 of -public COMMUNITY health and distribute them free of charge,
- 8 upon request, to persons who are subject to subsection (2). The
- 9 department of -public- COMMUNITY health shall provide copies of the
- 10 sign free of charge, upon request, to persons subject to subsection
- 11 (2) who do not purchase their supply of -cigarettes or other
- 12 tobacco products <u>described in subsection (1)</u> from <u>licensed</u>
- 13 wholesalers, secondary wholesalers, and unclassified acquirers of
- 14 cigarettes and other tobacco products -described in subsection (1)
- 15 LICENSED UNDER THE TOBACCO PRODUCTS TAX ACT, 1993 PA 327, MCL
- 16 205.421 TO 205.436.
- 17 (5) It is an affirmative defense to a charge pursuant to
- 18 UNDER subsection (1) that the defendant had in force at the time of
- 19 arrest and continues to have in force a written policy to prevent
- 20 the sale of -cigarettes, cigars, chewing tobacco, tobacco snuff,
- 21 and other tobacco products to persons under 18 years of age -,
- 22 and that the defendant enforced and continues to enforce the
- 23 policy. A defendant who proposes to offer evidence of the
- 24 affirmative defense described in this subsection shall file and
- 25 serve notice of the defense, in writing, upon the court and the
- 26 prosecuting attorney. The notice shall be served not less than 14
- 27 days before the date set for trial.

- 1 (6) A prosecuting attorney who proposes to offer testimony to
- 2 rebut the affirmative defense described in subsection (5) shall
- 3 file and serve a notice of rebuttal, in writing, upon the court and
- 4 the defendant. The notice shall be served not less than 7 days
- 5 before the date set for trial —, and shall contain the name and
- 6 address of each rebuttal witness.
- 7 (7) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO THE HANDLING OR
- 8 TRANSPORTATION OF A TOBACCO PRODUCT BY A MINOR UNDER THE TERMS OF
- 9 THAT MINOR'S EMPLOYMENT.
- 10 Sec. 2. (1) A person under 18 years of age shall not possess
- 11 or smoke cigarettes or cigars; or possess or chew, suck, or inhale
- 12 chewing tobacco or tobacco snuff; or possess or use tobacco in any
- 13 other form, on a public highway, street, alley, park, or other
- 14 lands used for public purposes, or in a public place of business or
- 15 amusement. A person A MINOR SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 16 (A) PURCHASE OR ATTEMPT TO PURCHASE A TOBACCO PRODUCT.
- 17 (B) POSSESS OR ATTEMPT TO POSSESS A TOBACCO PRODUCT.
- 18 (C) USE A TOBACCO PRODUCT IN A PUBLIC PLACE.
- 19 (D) PRESENT OR OFFER TO AN INDIVIDUAL A PURPORTED PROOF OF AGE
- 20 THAT IS FALSE, FRAUDULENT, OR NOT ACTUALLY HIS OR HER OWN PROOF OF
- 21 AGE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING, ATTEMPTING TO PURCHASE,
- 22 POSSESSING, OR ATTEMPTING TO POSSESS A TOBACCO PRODUCT.
- 23 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL who violates this section SUBSECTION (1)
- 24 is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more
- 25 than \$50.00 for each -offense- VIOLATION. Pursuant to a probation
- 26 order, the court may ALSO require a person who violates -this
- 27 section—SUBSECTION (1) to participate in a health promotion and

- 1 risk reduction assessment program, if available. A -probationer
- 2 PERSON who is ordered to participate in a health promotion and risk
- 3 reduction assessment program under this -section SUBSECTION is
- 4 responsible for the costs of participating in the program. In
- 5 addition, a person who violates this section SUBSECTION (1) is
- 6 subject to the following:
- 7 (a) For the first violation, the court may order the person to
- 8 do 1 of the following:
- 9 (i) Perform not more than 16 hours of community service in a
- 10 hospice, nursing home, or long-term care facility.
- 11 (ii) Participate in a health promotion and risk reduction
- 12 program, as described in this subsection.
- 13 (b) For a second violation, in addition to participation in a
- 14 health promotion and risk reduction program, the court may order
- 15 the person to perform not more than 32 hours of community service
- 16 in a hospice, nursing home, or long-term care facility.
- 17 (c) For a third or subsequent violation, in addition to
- 18 participation in a health promotion and risk reduction program, the
- 19 court may order the person to perform not more than 48 hours of
- 20 community service in a hospice, nursing home, or long-term care
- 21 facility.
- Sec. 4. As used in this act:
- 23 (a) "Chewing tobacco" means loose tobacco or a flat,
- 24 compressed cake of tobacco that is inserted into the mouth to be
- 25 chewed or sucked.
- 26 (A) "MINOR" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE.
- (b) "Person who sells tobacco products at retail" means a

- 1 person whose ordinary course of business consists, in whole or in
- 2 part, of the retail sale of tobacco products subject to state sales
- 3 tax.
- 4 (c) "Tobacco snuff" means shredded, powdered, or pulverized
- 5 tobacco that may be inhaled through the nostrils, chewed, or placed
- 6 against the gums.
- 7 (C) "PUBLIC PLACE" MEANS A PUBLIC STREET, SIDEWALK, OR PARK OR
- 8 ANY AREA OPEN TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC IN A PUBLICLY OWNED OR OPERATED
- 9 BUILDING OR PUBLIC PLACE OF BUSINESS.
- 10 (D) "TOBACCO PRODUCT" MEANS A PRODUCT THAT CONTAINS TOBACCO
- 11 AND IS INTENDED FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED
- 12 TO, CIGARETTES, NONCIGARETTE SMOKING TOBACCO, OR SMOKELESS TOBACCO,
- 13 AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION 2 OF THE TOBACCO PRODUCTS TAX
- 14 ACT, 1993 PA 327, MCL 205.422, AND CIGARS.
- 15 (E) "USE A TOBACCO PRODUCT" MEANS TO SMOKE, CHEW, SUCK,
- 16 INHALE, OR OTHERWISE CONSUME A TOBACCO PRODUCT.

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
