HOUSE BILL No. 5860

March 14, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Farhat and Kolb and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1966 PA 291, entitled
"Fire fighters training council act of 1966,"
by amending the title and sections 3, 9, 11, and 14 (MCL 29.363,
29.369, 29.371, and 29.374), the title and section 3 as amended by
1987 PA 196 and section 9 as amended by 1988 PA 458.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

2	An act to provide for the creation of a CREATE THE fire
3	fighters training council; to -provide for PRESCRIBE the powers
4	and duties of the council, THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL, and certain fire
5	departments -or AND other organizations; to -provide for the
6	establishment of CREATE the fire fighters training council fund
7	and TO PROVIDE FOR allocations — therefrom— FROM THE FUND to local
8	agencies of government participating in a -fire fighters
9	FIREFIGHTERS training program; and to make an appropriation.

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) The fire fighters training council is hereby
- 2 created -within IN THE BUREAU OF FIRE SERVICES IN the department
- 3 of state police LABOR AND ECONOMIC GROWTH and shall consist of 7
- 4 members selected as follows:
- 5 (a) The <u>director of state police</u> STATE FIRE MARSHAL, or his
- 6 or her designated representative, shall be ex-officio a member.
- 7 (b) Two members appointed to the council by the governor from
- 8 a list of 5 -active OR MORE members submitted by the Michigan
- 9 ASSOCIATION OF fire -chief's association CHIEFS.
- 10 (c) One member appointed to the council by the governor from a
- 11 list of 3 -active fire fighters OR MORE MEMBERS submitted by the
- 12 Michigan -state fire fighter's association PROFESSIONAL FIRE
- 13 FIGHTERS UNION.
- 14 (d) One member appointed to the council by the governor from a
- 15 list of 3 OR MORE names submitted by the Michigan state firemen's
- 16 association.
- 17 (e) One member appointed to the council by the governor from a
- 18 list of 3 OR MORE names submitted by the -metropolitan club of
- 19 America, incorporated MICHIGAN FIRE SERVICES INSTRUCTION
- 20 ASSOCIATION.
- 21 (f) One member appointed to the council by the governor from a
- 22 list of 2 OR MORE names submitted by the Michigan townships
- 23 association and 2 OR MORE names submitted by the Michigan municipal
- 24 league.
- 25 (2) All appointments made by the governor shall be with the
- 26 advice and consent of the senate.
- 27 Sec. 9. (1) The STATE FIRE MARSHAL, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE

- 1 council, shall prepare and publish standards with due consideration
- 2 to varying factors and special requirements of fire departments or
- 3 other organizations in the following areas:
- 4 (a) Advisory standards of physical, educational, mental and
- 5 moral fitness, which shall govern the recruitment, selection, and
- 6 appointment of fire fighters FIREFIGHTERS.
- 7 (b) The approval by the council of <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER
- 8 training schools. The standards shall address, at least, the
- 9 following issues:
- 10 (i) The qualification and certification of instructors.
- 11 (ii) The courses of study, attendance, record-keeping
- 12 requirements, equipment, and facilities.
- 13 (iii) The visitation and evaluation of instructors and schools.
- 14 by the council.
- 15 (c) The establishment of subordinate regional training centers
- 16 in strategic geographic locations in order to serve the greatest
- 17 number of fire departments that are unable to support their own
- 18 training programs.
- 19 (2) Each fire department or other organization shall file a
- 20 statement with the council designating at least 1 training officer
- 21 or training coordinator for the fire department. by November 30,
- 22 1988.— If a training officer or training coordinator is changed,
- 23 the fire department or other organization, within 7 days of the
- 24 change, shall file a statement notifying the council of the change.
- 25 (3) The council shall develop and provide to each fire
- 26 department or other organization, upon request of the fire
- 27 department or other organization and at no charge, a videotape to

- 1 be used in training <u>fire fighters</u> **FIREFIGHTERS**. The videotape
- 2 shall not include training that requires a practical demonstration.
- 3 The videotape shall be based on the fire fighters I and II
- 4 standards set forth in -the- "STANDARD FOR fire fighter
- 5 professional qualifications", national fire protection association
- 6 pamphlet STANDARD no. 1001, -1987 2002 edition. The council may
- 7 impose a reasonable fee for loss, damage, or late return of a
- 8 videotape provided to a fire department or other organization under
- 9 this subsection.
- 10 (4) The STATE FIRE MARSHAL, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE council,
- 11 shall develop and administer an examination, which shall include a
- 12 practical demonstration, a written or oral test, or a combination
- 13 thereof, to determine a person's competency in regard to the
- 14 knowledge and skill requirements set forth in fire fighter I and II
- 15 standards of -the- "STANDARD FOR fire fighter professional
- 16 qualifications", national fire protection association pamphlet
- 17 STANDARD no. 1001, $\frac{1987}{}$ 2002 edition. The council, upon the
- 18 request of a fire department or other organization, shall
- 19 administer the examination in each county at least once every year.
- 20 The examination shall be administered in 2 parts. Part 1 shall test
- 21 the knowledge and skill requirements set forth in fire fighter I,
- 22 and part 2 shall test the knowledge and skill requirements set
- 23 forth in fire fighter II. The examination may be retaken, as
- 24 necessary, upon request from a fire department or other
- 25 organization.
- 26 (5) Within 12 months after a person's hiring date as a full-
- 27 time <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER, the person must pass both part 1

- 1 and part 2 of the examination to be eligible for continued or
- 2 permanent full-time employment as a <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER.
- **3** (6) Within 24 months after a person's appointment date as a
- 4 volunteer or paid on-call <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER, a person must
- 5 pass part 1 of the examination to be eligible for continued
- 6 volunteer or paid on-call service as a <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER.
- 7 (7) The examination described in this section shall not apply
- 8 to a person who is employed or under appointment as a fire fighter
- **9** FIREFIGHTER on October 1, 1988, unless -a THE person subsequently
- 10 changes his or her status from a volunteer or paid on-call -fire
- 11 fighter FIREFIGHTER to a full-time -fire fighter FIREFIGHTER.
- 12 (8) The STATE FIRE MARSHAL, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE council,
- 13 shall review and monitor the state and federal standards relating
- 14 to live fire training exercises in structures and make
- 15 recommendations to the general industry safety standards commission
- 16 for any new or modified standards which in their opinion are
- 17 necessary for the protection of <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER
- 18 trainees.
- 19 Sec. 11. The STATE FIRE MARSHAL AND THE council may:
- 20 (a) Visit and inspect any <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER training
- 21 school, or examine the curriculum or training procedures, for which
- 22 application for approval has been made.
- 23 (b) Issue certificates to <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER training
- 24 schools qualifying under the regulations -of the council
- 25 PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT.
- 26 (c) Authorize the issuance of certificates of graduation or
- 27 diplomas by approved <u>fire fighter</u> FIREFIGHTER training schools to

- 1 fire fighters FIREFIGHTERS who have satisfactorily completed
- 2 minimum courses of study.
- 3 (d) Cooperate with state, federal, AND local fire agencies in
- 4 establishing and conducting local or area schools or regional
- 5 training centers for instruction and training of fire fighters
- 6 FIREFIGHTERS of this state AND its cities, counties, townships,
- 7 and villages.
- 8 (e) Make recommendations to THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL, THE
- 9 GOVERNOR, AND the legislature on matters pertaining to
- 10 qualification and training of <u>fire fighters</u> FIREFIGHTERS.
- 11 Sec. 14. (1) The amounts annually appropriated by the
- 12 legislature shall be paid by the state treasurer in accordance with
- 13 the accounting laws of -the- THIS state upon certification of the
- 14 executive secretary of the council for the purpose of reimbursing
- 15 the A city, county, township, or village for -regular fire
- 16 fighters THE FOLLOWING:
- 17 (A) REGULAR FIREFIGHTERS in the fire department in an amount
- 18 not to exceed 1/2 of the salary paid to each <u>fire fighter</u>
- 19 FIREFIGHTER meeting the recruitment standards and participating in
- 20 training -meeting THAT MEETS the standard prescribed pursuant to
- 21 this act during the period covered by the allocation, plus \$8.00 of
- 22 the necessary living expenses incurred by -such fire fighter which
- 23 THE FIREFIGHTER THAT are necessitated by BECAUSE THE training
- 24 requiring that he REQUIRES THE FIREFIGHTER TO be away from his
- 25 THE FIREFIGHTER'S residence overnight. The amounts annually
- 26 appropriated by the legislature shall be paid by the state
- 27 treasurer in accordance with the accounting laws of the state upon

- 1 certification of the executive secretary of the council for the
- 2 purpose of reimbursing the city, county, township or village for
- 3 volunteer fire fighters
- 4 (B) VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS in an amount not to exceed \$12.50
- 5 for lost wages, to be matched by the local municipality for each
- 6 fire fighter FIREFIGHTER meeting the recruitment standards and
- 7 participating in training -meeting THAT MEETS the standard
- 8 prescribed pursuant to this act during the period covered by the
- 9 allocation, plus \$8.00 of the necessary living expenses, to be
- 10 matched by the local municipality, incurred by -such fire fighter
- 11 which THE FIREFIGHTER THAT are necessitated by BECAUSE THE
- 12 training -requiring that he REQUIRES THE FIREFIGHTER TO be away
- 13 from <u>his</u> THE FIREFIGHTER'S residence overnight.
- 14 (2) If the -moneys MONEY in the fire fighter training fund to
- 15 be appropriated by the legislature for -such- salary and expense
- 16 reimbursement are UNDER THIS SECTION IS insufficient to allocate
- 17 such THE amount to each participating city, county, township, or
- 18 village, the amount allocated to each shall be reduced
- 20 (3) AN ALLOCATION SHALL NOT be made UNDER THIS SECTION to any
- 21 city, county, township, or village -which THAT has not, throughout
- 22 the period covered by the allocation, adhered to the standards
- 23 established by the council UNDER THIS ACT as applicable to
- 24 personnel recruited or trained by -such- THE city, county,
- 25 township, or village during —such— THE period.
- 26 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
