## **HOUSE BILL No. 6016**

April 27, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Palmer, Taub, Elsenheimer, Hoogendyk, Hummel, Walker, Sheltrown, Emmons, Casperson and Marleau and referred to the Committee on Higher Education and Career Preparation.

A bill to amend 1964 PA 142, entitled

"An act to authorize the state department of education to provide minimum requirements for nonincorporated privately operated institutions which purport to offer degrees, diplomas or certificates based on education beyond high school, or education for transfer to institutions of higher learning,"

by amending the title and sections 1 and 2 (MCL 390.771 and 390.772).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

An act to authorize the state department of education to
