HOUSE BILL No. 6262

June 22, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Ward, Stahl and Schuitmaker and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Great Lakes, Land Use, and Environment.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 399, entitled "Safe drinking water act,"

(MCL 325.1001 to 325.1023) by adding section 11e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 11E. (1) THE ARSENIC IN DRINKING WATER GRANT FUND IS
- 2 CREATED WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE
- 3 MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND.
- 4 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND.
- 5 (2) MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL
- 6 REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.
- 7 (3) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND
 - EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
 - (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE FUND, UPON
 - APPROPRIATION, TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO PERSONS WHOSE SOURCE OF

- 1 DRINKING WATER EXCEEDS THE STATE DRINKING WATER STANDARD FOR
- 2 ARSENIC TO DO EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 3 (A) TREAT THE DRINKING WATER TO REDUCE THE LEVELS OF ARSENIC.
- 4 (B) OBTAIN AN ALTERNATIVE SOURCE OF DRINKING WATER.
- 5 (5) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A GRANT PROGRAM TO RECEIVE

- 10 DRINKING WATER GRANT FUND CREATED IN SUBSECTION (1).
