

SENATE BILL No. 249

February 24, 2005, Introduced by Senators CLARKE, CROPSEY, CHERRY, BASHAM, OLSHOVE, HARDIMAN, PRUSI, SWITALSKI, BROWN, BIRKHOLZ, GOSCHKA, GARCIA, STAMAS, JACOBS, SCOTT, VAN WOERKOM, KUIPERS, CLARK-COLEMAN, ALLEN, HAMMERSTROM, BRATER and SCHAUER and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 143a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 143A. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL OR RENT A RESTRICTED
2 VIDEO GAME TO A PERSON WHO IS LESS THAN 17 YEARS OF AGE. AS USED IN
3 THIS SECTION, "RESTRICTED VIDEO GAME" MEANS A VIDEO GAME RATED AO
4 (ADULTS ONLY) OR M (MATURE) BY THE ENTERTAINMENT SOFTWARE RATING
5 BOARD.
6 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
7 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR

1 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
