tentative zoning plan to the county board of commissioners, the county zoning commission shall hold at least 1 public hearing.

Notice of the hearing shall be given by 2 publications in a newspaper published in the county or, if a newspaper is not published in the county, then in a newspaper published in an adjacent county. The first publication shall be printed not more than 30 days and not less than 20 days, and the second not more than 8 days before the date of the hearing.
