

SENATE BILL No. 320

March 17, 2005, Introduced by Senators PRUSI, SCHAUER, EMERSON, BRATER, CLARK-COLEMAN, CLARKE, BASHAM, OLSHOVE, JACOBS, LELAND, BERNERO, BARCIA, CHERRY, SWITALSKI, THOMAS and SCOTT and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Labor.

A bill to amend 1964 PA 154, entitled "Minimum wage law of 1964," by amending section 4 (MCL 408.384), as amended by 1997 PA 2.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 4. (1) Subject to the exceptions specified in this act,
2 the minimum hourly wage rate shall be:

3 ~~(a) Beginning January 1, 1981, \$3.35.~~

4 ~~(b) Beginning May 1, 1997, \$4.75.~~

5 (A) ~~—(e)~~ Beginning September 1, 1997, \$5.15.
