SENATE BILL No. 898

November 10, 2005, Introduced by Senators KUIPERS and JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1966 PA 331, entitled "Community college act of 1966,"

by amending sections 123 and 124 (MCL 389.123 and 389.124), section 123 as amended by 1980 PA 5 and section 124 as amended by 1997 PA 135.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 123. The board of trustees may:

- (a) Have the care and custody of the community college property and provide suitable facilities, sanitary conditions, and medical inspection for the community college of the district.
- (b) Establish and collect tuition and fees for resident and nonresident students. A waiver of tuition shall not be granted by the board, except:
 - (i) The board of trustees may waive tuition for a student

- 1 participating in a reciprocal agreement for exchange of educational
- 2 services, if the agreement is approved by the state board of
- 3 education.
- 4 (ii) The board of trustees may waive tuition for a student who
- 5 meets the admission requirements of the board and is 60 years of
- 6 age or older.
- 7 (c) Establish and maintain or continue a library or museum,
- 8 which may be separately operated if desired, for the community
- 9 college, if the board of trustees considers it advisable to
- 10 establish and maintain or continue a library or museum and to
- 11 provide for its care and management.
- 12 (D) SELECT AND EMPLOY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS, TEACHERS, AND
- 13 OTHER EMPLOYEES IT FINDS NECESSARY TO OPERATE THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE
- 14 DISTRICT AND ESTABLISH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THEIR SERVICE OR
- 15 EMPLOYMENT. IF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES PROVIDE MEDICAL, OPTICAL, AND
- 16 DENTAL BENEFITS TO EMPLOYEES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS, THE BOARD SHALL
- 17 PROVIDE THOSE BENEFITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHOOL EMPLOYEES
- 18 HEALTH BENEFIT ACT AND SHALL COMPLY WITH THAT ACT.
- 19 Sec. 124. The board of trustees may do all of the following:
- 20 (a) Contract with, appoint, and employ a suitable person as
- 21 chief executive officer of the community college. The person
- 22 employed as chief executive officer shall not be a member of the
- 23 board of trustees and shall possess at least an earned bachelor's
- 24 degree from an accredited college or university. The chief
- 25 executive officer shall hold office for a term fixed by the board
- 26 of trustees, not to exceed 5 years, shall perform duties as the
- 27 board of trustees may determine, and shall make reports in writing

- 2 annually, or more often if required, in regard to all matters
- 3 pertaining to the educational interests of the community college
- 4 district.
- 5 (b) Delegate to the chief executive officer of the community
- 6 college the board's authority to do any of the following:
- 7 (i) Select and employ personnel of the community college. IF
- 8 THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER PROVIDES MEDICAL, OPTICAL, AND DENTAL
- 9 BENEFITS TO EMPLOYEES AND THEIR DEPENDENTS UNDER THIS SUBPARAGRAPH,
- 10 THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER SHALL PROVIDE THOSE BENEFITS IN
- 11 ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHOOL EMPLOYEES HEALTH BENEFIT ACT AND SHALL
- 12 COMPLY WITH THAT ACT.
- 13 (ii) Pay claims and demands against the community college.
- 14 (iii) Purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire personal property
- 15 for the community college.
- 16 (iv) Invest community college funds.
- 17 (v) Subject to terms and conditions established by the board
- 18 of directors, accept contributions, capital grants, gifts,
- 19 donations, services, or other financial assistance from any public
- 20 or private entity.
- 21 (c) Appoint and employ a business manager responsible to the
- 22 chief executive officer of the community college for the community
- 23 college district and fix his or her term of office.
- 24 (d) Select and employ other administrative officers, teachers,
- 25 and other employees and engage services as necessary to effectuate
- 26 its purposes.
- 27 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
