

# SENATE BILL No. 903

November 29, 2005, Introduced by Senators STAMAS, GILBERT, KUIPERS, JELINEK, ALLEN, GARCIA, BROWN, SANBORN and GOSCHKA and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 218, entitled  
"The insurance code of 1956,"  
(MCL 500.100 to 500.8302) by adding section 2027a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 2027A. (1) IT IS AN UNFAIR METHOD OF COMPETITION AND AN  
2 UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE ACT OR PRACTICE IN THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE TO  
3 REQUIRE AN INSURED OR APPLICANT FOR INSURANCE TO HAVE INSTALLED IN  
4 HIS OR HER AUTOMOBILE AN EVENT DATA RECORDER OR TO REQUEST OR USE  
5 DATA RECORDED ON AN EVENT DATA RECORDER TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY  
6 FOR, OR TO DETERMINE PREMIUMS FOR, AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE.

7           (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "EVENT DATA RECORDER" MEANS THAT  
8 TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 682C OF THE MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949

1 PA 300, MCL 257.682C.

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
3 unless Senate Bill No. 902

4 of the 93rd Legislature is enacted into law.
