

**FY 2007-08 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS**  
**House Bill 5344 (PA 113 of 2008)**  
**Summary: Enacted Bill**



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**Overview**

House Bill 5344, enacted as Public Act 113 of 2008, is a fiscal year 2007-08 supplemental budget bill. The enacted version of the bill contains appropriations totaling \$142.9 million Gross and \$41.3 million GF/GP. An attached table compares the appropriation items in the enacted bill with the items recommended by the State Budget Office (SBO) and the items included in the House- and Senate-passed versions of the bill. Two items, appropriations totaling \$1.0 million GF/GP for business incubators in Macomb and Washtenaw Counties, were vetoed by the Governor.

The bill concurs with the SBO recommendation for a negative appropriation of \$30.0 million GF/GP for projected debt service savings in the Department of Treasury budget. Those savings partially offset the positive GF/GP appropriations of \$72.3 million in the bill.

A second attached table compares boilerplate items in the enacted bill with the items recommended by the SBO and the items included in the House- and Senate-passed versions of the bill. The Governor's signature letter for the bill asserts that section 521 of the bill, which provides for performance reviews of state departments, is legally unenforceable because no associated appropriation is included in the bill.
