HOUSE BILL No. 6689

November 19, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Hopgood and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 618a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 618A. (1) UNLESS THE OPERATOR OF A MOTOR VEHICLE INVOLVED
- 2 IN AN ACCIDENT KNOWS OR REASONABLY SHOULD KNOW THAT SERIOUS
- 3 IMPAIRMENT OF A BODILY FUNCTION OR DEATH HAS RESULTED FROM THE
- 4 ACCIDENT, THE OPERATOR OR ANY OTHER OCCUPANT OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE
- 5 WHO POSSESSES A VALID DRIVER LICENSE SHALL REMOVE THE MOTOR VEHICLE
- 6 FROM THE MAIN TRAVELED PORTION OF THE ROADWAY INTO A SAFE REFUGE ON
- 7 THE SHOULDER, EMERGENCY LANE, OR MEDIAN OR TO A PLACE OTHERWISE
- REMOVED FROM THE ROADWAY IF BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
 - (A) MOVING THE MOTOR VEHICLE CAN BE DONE SAFELY.

- 1 (B) THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS CAPABLE OF BEING NORMALLY AND SAFELY
- 2 OPERATED AND CAN BE OPERATED UNDER ITS OWN POWER IN ITS CUSTOMARY
- 3 MANNER WITHOUT FURTHER DAMAGE OR HAZARD TO THE TRAFFIC ELEMENTS OR
- 4 TO THE ROADWAY.
- 5 (2) THE OPERATOR OR ANY OTHER PERSON WHO REMOVES A MOTOR
- 6 VEHICLE FROM THE MAIN TRAVELED PORTION OF THE ROADWAY AS PROVIDED
- 7 IN THIS SECTION BEFORE THE ARRIVAL OF A POLICE OFFICER IS NOT PRIMA
- 8 FACIE AT FAULT REGARDING THE CAUSE OF THE TRAFFIC ACCIDENT SOLELY
- 9 BY REASON OF MOVING THE MOTOR VEHICLE AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.
- 10 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A
- 11 CIVIL INFRACTION.
