by amending section 811e (MCL 257.811e), as amended by 2006 PA 562, and by adding section 811r.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 811e. (1) Beginning January 1, 2007, the **THE** secretary of state may develop a fund-raising plate as provided in this section.

(2) A start-up fee of \$15,000.00 shall be paid for any new fund-raising plate authorized under this section, which fee shall be deposited in the transportation administration collection fund to be used for the cost of creating, producing, and issuing fund-raising plates. If the fee described in this subsection is not paid within 18 months of—AFTER the effective date of the public act that authorizes the development and issuance of a fund-raising plate,
