SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 643

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 708b (MCL 257.708b), as amended by 2004 PA 362.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 708b. (1) A person shall not equip or operate a motor
- 2 vehicle that is to be used upon the highways of this state with a
- 3 television viewer, screen, or other means of visually receiving a
- 4 television or video broadcast which OR OTHER SIMILAR ELECTRONIC
- 5 DEVICE THAT DISPLAYS A VIDEO IMAGE THAT can be viewed by or
- 6 reflected to the driver OPERATOR WHILE THE VEHICLE IS IN MOTION.
- 7 (2) This section does not apply to:
- 8 (a) A radio AN AUDIO ENTERTAINMENT SYSTEM, heating and OR air-
- 9 conditioning CONTROLS, or other accessory controls in the motor

- 1 vehicle.
- 2 (b) Driver, passenger, and A vehicle information and OR
- 3 navigation systems SYSTEM FOR USE IN displaying ONLY information
- 4 pertaining to vehicle location, available routes and destinations,
- 5 road layouts, weather conditions, traffic and road conditions, and
- 6 vehicle conditions, OR TRAVELER SERVICES.
- 7 (c) Research vehicles A RESEARCH VEHICLE if the test plan for
- 8 the vehicle has been approved by a process meeting federal
- 9 guidelines established in 45 CFR part 46 for the protection of
- 10 human beings and the vehicle has been issued a special registration
- 11 permit by the secretary of state.
- 12 (d) A motor vehicle equipped with a video display to monitor
- 13 the rear view of the vehicle if the monitor is only activated when
- 14 the vehicle is motionless or in reverse gear and is deactivated
- 15 within 15 seconds after the motor vehicle's transmission is shifted
- 16 out of reverse gear ENHANCE OR SUPPLEMENT THE DRIVER'S VIEW.
- 17 (E) A POLICE VEHICLE, FIRE VEHICLE, OR AMBULANCE EQUIPPED WITH
- 18 A MONITOR FOR USE WITH A COMPUTER-AIDED DISPATCH SYSTEM OR
- 19 EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT CONTROLS.
- 20 (F) A POLICE VEHICLE EQUIPPED WITH A MONITOR FOR USE WITH
- 21 RECORDING EQUIPMENT.
- 22 (3) A visual device permitted under subsection (2)(b) (2)(A)
- 23 OR (B) shall be built into the dashboard or other control area of
- 24 the vehicle and shall meet all applicable federal motor vehicle
- 25 dash safety standards. AN AFTERMARKET VISUAL DEVICE SHALL NOT BE
- 26 INSTALLED OR MOUNTED ON THE WINDSHIELD, ABOVE THE DASHBOARD, IN AN
- 27 AREA WITHIN THE DEPLOYMENT PROFILE OF THE VEHICLE AIR BAGS, OR IN A

- 1 MANNER THAT INTERFERES WITH THE OPERATOR'S VIEW OR CONTROL. This
- 2 subsection does not apply to a NAVIGATIONAL DEVICE DESCRIBED IN
- 3 SUBSECTION (2) (B) OR TO research vehicle described in subsection
- **4** (2)(c).
- 5 (4) Upon receipt of a completed application, on a form
- 6 prescribed by the secretary of state, and payment of a fee of
- 7 \$10.00, the secretary of state may issue a special permit
- 8 authorizing a research vehicle to use the highways of this state. A
- 9 copy of the authority received by the applicant under subsection
- 10 (2)(c) shall be submitted as part of the application for the
- 11 special permit. The special permit may be in a form as prescribed
- 12 by, and shall be displayed on a research vehicle in a manner
- 13 determined by, the secretary of state. The special permit shall
- 14 expire upon completion of or expiration of the specific test plan
- 15 approved under subsection (2)(c), whichever occurs first, and shall
- 16 be immediately removed from the research vehicle and destroyed. A
- 17 special permit shall not be transferred to another vehicle or
- 18 person. The fee collected under this subsection shall be credited
- 19 to the Michigan transportation fund and used to defray the expenses
- 20 of the secretary of state in administering the special permit
- 21 program. In addition to a special permit, the appropriate vehicle
- 22 registration plate shall be displayed on a research vehicle to use
- 23 a highway of this state.
- 24 (5) A person who violates this section is responsible for a
- 25 civil infraction.
