A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 874 (MCL 600.874).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 874. (1) The—FOR PERFORMING A MARRIAGE CEREMONY, THE
- 2 probate court shall charge and THE COUNTY CLERK OF THE COUNTY WHERE
- 3 THE MARRIAGE IS PERFORMED SHALL collect the following fees:
- 4 (a) For performing a marriage ceremony, \$10.00 OR A FEE THAT
- 5 SHALL NOT EXCEED \$40.00 AS DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF
- 6 COMMISSIONERS IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE MARRIAGE CEREMONY IS
- 7 PERFORMED.
- 8 (2) THE PROBATE COURT SHALL CHARGE AND COLLECT THE FOLLOWING
  9 FEES:
  - (A)  $\frac{\text{(b)}}{\text{For issuance of a commission to take testimony, } 7.00.$

- 1 (B) (c) For taking, certifying, sealing, and forwarding
- 2 depositions, \$5.00, and 10 cents per folio, which fees shall be
- 3 considered as costs in the case; and for each copy of the
- 4 deposition furnished, 3 cents per folio.
- 5 (3) (2)—A probate judge may waive the fee for performing a
- 6 marriage ceremony if the parties thereto TO THE MARRIAGE are
- 7 indigent.
