

HOUSE BILL No. 4849

May 24, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Jackson and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 8317 (MCL 324.8317), as amended by 2003 PA 82;
and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 8317. (1) An application submitted under this part shall
2 be accompanied by the following application fee:

3 (a) For a commercial applicator certification, \$75.00.

4 (b) For a private agricultural applicator certification,
5 \$50.00. ~~if paid on October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2007, and~~
6 ~~\$10.00 if paid through September 30, 2003 or after September 30,~~
7 ~~2007.~~

8 (c) For a commercial registered applicator, \$45.00.

1 (d) For a private registered applicator, \$50.00. ~~if paid on~~
2 ~~October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2007, and \$10.00 if paid~~
3 ~~through September 30, 2003 or after September 30, 2007.~~

4 (2) Certificates for commercial applicators, private
5 agricultural applicators, and registered applicators shall be valid
6 for a period of time of not less than 3 years to be established by
7 rule by the director.

8 (3) The license application fee for a commercial applicator
9 license is \$100.00. The license shall expire on December 31
10 annually.

11 (4) The registration application fee for the registration of
12 pesticides sold, offered, exposed for sale, or distributed is
13 \$40.00 per product.

14 (5) The license application fee for a restricted use pesticide
15 dealer's license is \$100.00. The license shall expire annually on
16 December 31.

17 (6) Application fees submitted under this section are not
18 refundable.

19 (7) **THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEPOSIT LICENSE FEES AND**
20 **ADMINISTRATIVE FINES RECEIVED UNDER THIS PART IN THE AGRICULTURE**
21 **LICENSING AND INSPECTION FEES FUND CREATED IN SECTION 4 OF 1969 PA**
22 **287, MCL 287.334, TO BE USED PURSUANT TO APPROPRIATION BY THE**
23 **DIRECTOR IN ADMINISTERING AND CARRYING OUT THOSE DUTIES REQUIRED BY**
24 **LAW UNDER THIS PART.**

25 (8) **EVERY 3 YEARS, THE DEPARTMENT BY ORDER MAY ADJUST THE FEE**
26 **SCHEDULE IN THIS SECTION BY AN AMOUNT DETERMINED BY THE STATE**
27 **TREASURER TO REFLECT THE CUMULATIVE ANNUAL PERCENTAGE CHANGE IN THE**

1 DETROIT CONSUMER PRICE INDEX OVER THE 3-YEAR PERIOD. AN ADJUSTMENT
2 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT EXCEED 5% EVEN IF THE AMOUNT
3 DETERMINED BY THE STATE TREASURER TO REFLECT THE CUMULATIVE ANNUAL
4 PERCENTAGE CHANGE OVER THE 3-YEAR PERIOD IS MORE THAN 5%. AS USED
5 IN THIS SUBSECTION, "DETROIT CONSUMER PRICE INDEX" MEANS THE MOST
6 COMPREHENSIVE INDEX OF CONSUMER PRICES AVAILABLE FOR THE DETROIT
7 AREA FROM THE BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS OF THE UNITED STATES
8 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR.

9 Enacting section 1. Section 8318 of the natural resources and
10 environmental protection act, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.8318, is
11 repealed.
