HOUSE BILL No. 5031

July 18, 2007, Introduced by Reps. LeBlanc and Sak and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Outdoor Recreation and Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 43537 (MCL 324.43537), as amended by 1996 PA 585.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 43537. (1) A resident who is declared legally blind is

- eligible to purchase a senior restricted or senior all-species

 fishing license. The department may demand proof of blindness. The

 licensee, when fishing, shall possess proof of blindness and shall

 furnish the proof upon the request of a peace officer.

 (2) A resident who has been determined by the United States

 department of veterans affairs to be permanently and totally
 - department of veterans affairs to be permanently and totally disabled and entitled to veteran benefits at the 100% rate, for a disability other than blindness, DISABLED VETERAN is eligible to

- 1 purchase any senior hunting license as described in section 43535
- 2 or any senior fishing license described in section 43536, or both.
- 3 (3) THERE SHALL BE A DISABLED VETERANS FIREARM DEER SEASON ON

- 17 proof upon the request of a peace officer.

- 19 this section SUBSECTION (2) in the same manner as licenses issued
- 20 to senior citizens for purposes of receiving appropriations from
- 21 the legislature under section 43546.
- 22 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "DISABLED VETERAN" MEANS A
- 23 RESIDENT WHO HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
- 24 VETERANS AFFAIRS TO BE PERMANENTLY AND TOTALLY DISABLED AS A RESULT
- 25 OF MILITARY SERVICE AND ENTITLED TO VETERANS' BENEFITS AT THE 100%
- 26 RATE, FOR A DISABILITY OTHER THAN BLINDNESS.
