- 1 SEC. 2128. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DEVELOP BY OCTOBER 1, 2007 A
- 2 COMPREHENSIVE CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAM. THE CONSUMER AWARENESS
- 3 PROGRAM SHALL BE DESIGNED TO EDUCATE RESIDENTS OF THIS STATE ON
- 4 SPECIFIC ACTIONS THAT STATE RESIDENTS CAN TAKE TO REDUCE HOME AND
- 5 AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE PREMIUMS. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMOTE THE
- 6 CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAM BY DECEMBER 1, 2007.
