(MCL 289.1101 to 289.8111) by adding section 5104.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 5104. (1) A FOOD ESTABLISHMENT SHALL NOT SELL AN ENERGY
- 2 DRINK TO AN INDIVIDUAL LESS THAN 17 YEARS OF AGE.
- 3 (2) A FOOD ESTABLISHMENT DETERMINED TO HAVE VIOLATED
- 4 SUBSECTION (1) IS SUBJECT ONLY TO ADMINISTRATIVE FINES AND COSTS
- 5 UNDER SECTION 5105.
- (3) IN AN ACTION FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION, PROOF THAT
  - THE DEFENDANT OR THE DEFENDANT'S AGENT OR EMPLOYEE DEMANDED AND WAS
- 8 SHOWN, BEFORE FURNISHING AN ENERGY DRINK TO AN INDIVIDUAL LESS THAN
- 9 17 YEARS OF AGE, A MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE
