A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 20174a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 20174A. (1) A SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST DESCRIBED IN SECTION
- 2 20174(2) OR (3) WHO IS EMPLOYED BY, UNDER INDEPENDENT CONTRACT
- 3 WITH, OR GRANTED CLINICAL PRIVILEGES BY A HOSPITAL, FREESTANDING
- 4 SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY, OR ANY OTHER ENTITY SHALL ANNUALLY
- 5 COMPLETE 15 HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION TO REMAIN QUALIFIED FOR
- 6 AND RETAIN THAT EMPLOYMENT, CONTRACT, OR CLINICAL PRIVILEGES.
- 7 (2) A HOSPITAL, FREESTANDING SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY, OR
