A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 361a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT: SEC. 361A. (1) A PERSON WHO COMMITS LARCENY BY STEALING ALL OR PART OF A TOMB, MONUMENT, GRAVESTONE, OR ALL OR PART OF A COMMEMORATIVE, DECORATIVE, OR OTHER CEMETERY-RELATED ARTICLE CONTAINING NONFERROUS METAL IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 90 DAYS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.

7 (2) THE COURT SHALL AWARD RESTITUTION FOR THE VALUE OF THE
8 NONFERROUS METAL ARTICLE STOLEN. THE COURT MAY AWARD COSTS
9 REGARDING ANY ASPECT OF A PROSECUTION BROUGHT UNDER SUBSECTION (1).
