- SEC. 4003. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL LIFE INSURANCE POLICY SHALL NOT
 LAPSE, TERMINATE, OR BE FORFEITED FOR NONPAYMENT OF PREMIUMS OR
 INTEREST OR INDEBTEDNESS ON A PREMIUM IF PROTECTION IS APPLIED FOR
 AND GRANTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 401 TO 409 OF THE SOLDIERS' AND
 SAILORS' CIVIL RELIEF ACT OF 1940, 50 USC APP. 540 TO 549.

 (2) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER PENALTY THAT MAY BE PROVIDED BY
 LAW, IF THE COMMISSIONER FINDS THAT A PERSON HAS VIOLATED THIS
