THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 624C. (1) A PERSON WHO OPERATES A MOTOR VEHICLE IN
- 2 VIOLATION OF SECTION 624A WITH ANY BODILY ALCOHOL CONTENT IS GUILTY
- 3 OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE AS FOLLOWS:
- 4 (A) IF THE PERSON CAUSES BODILY INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON, BY
- 5 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 5 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN
- 6 \$1,000.00 OR MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 7 (B) IF THE PERSON CAUSES THE DEATH OF ANOTHER PERSON, BY
- 8 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 15 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN
- 9 \$2,500.00 OR MORE THAN \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.
 - (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "ANY BODILY ALCOHOL CONTENT"
