SENATE BILL No. 1412

June 24, 2008, Introduced by Senators SWITALSKI and CLARKE and referred to the Committee on Campaign and Election Oversight.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 317.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 317. (1) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2009 AND THROUGH DECEMBER
- 2 31, 2010, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ESTABLISH A PILOT PROJECT TO
- 3 TEST THE FOLLOWING IN SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS:
- (A) INTERNET VOTING.
 - (B) VOTING BY MAIL.
 - (C) A COMBINATION OF INTERNET VOTING AND VOTING BY MAIL.
- (2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SELECT NOT FEWER THAN 6 OR
- 8 MORE THAN 12 SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO TEST INTERNET VOTING, VOTING BY
- MAIL, OR A COMBINATION OF INTERNET VOTING AND VOTING BY MAIL IN

- 1 COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SECTION. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL APPROVE

- 15 SHALL COOPERATE WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE IN CONDUCTING A PILOT
- 16 PROJECT SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTION INVOLVING INTERNET VOTING, VOTING
- 17 BY MAIL, OR A COMBINATION OF INTERNET VOTING AND VOTING BY MAIL.
- 18 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL IMPLEMENT INTERNET VOTING,

- 22 (5) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL PRESCRIBE THE PROCEDURES FOR

- 24 (6) BEFORE MARCH 31, 2011, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SUBMIT
- 25 A REPORT TO THE HOUSE AND SENATE COMMITTEES THAT CONSIDER ELECTION
- 26 ISSUES. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING

- 12 CONCERNING STATEWIDE INTERNET VOTING AND STATEWIDE VOTING BY MAIL.
- 13 (F) ANY OTHER INFORMATION THE SECRETARY OF STATE CONSIDERS
- 14 RELEVANT.
- 15 (7) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 16 (A) "INTERNET VOTING" MEANS THE ACT OF VOTING IN A SCHOOL
- 17 DISTRICT ELECTION BY A QUALIFIED AND REGISTERED ELECTOR UTILIZING
- 18 THE INTERNET AT HOME OR UTILIZING AN INTERNET VOTING SYSTEM.
- 19 (B) "INTERNET VOTING SYSTEM" MEANS A VOTING SYSTEM AT A
- 20 POLLING PLACE APPROVED FOR USE BY THE BOARD OF STATE CANVASSERS
- 21 THAT ALLOWS AN ELECTOR TO SECRETLY AND SECURELY TRANSMIT HIS OR HER
- 22 VOTED BALLOT TO ELECTIONS OFFICIALS BY UTILIZING THE INTERNET.
- 23 (C) "LARGE SCHOOL DISTRICT" MEANS A SCHOOL DISTRICT WITH 5,000
- 24 OR MORE PUPILS.
- 25 (D) "RURAL SCHOOL DISTRICT" MEANS A SCHOOL DISTRICT THAT HAS A
- 26 POPULATION DENSITY OF 100 OR FEWER PERSONS PER SQUARE MILE AS
- 27 DETERMINED BY THE MOST RECENT FEDERAL DECENNIAL CENSUS.
