

SUBSTITUTE FOR  
HOUSE BILL NO. 4132

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled  
"The revised school code,"  
by amending section 1596 (MCL 380.1596).

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 1596. (1) The board of a school district other than a  
2 primary school district may establish 1 or more ungraded schools  
3 for the instruction of certain pupils classified in subsection (2).  
4 The board may require the pupils to attend an ungraded school or a  
5 department of the school as the board directs.

6           (2) ~~The following cases of persons, aged~~ **A CHILD AGE 7** to the  
7 **HIS OR HER** sixteenth birthday, ~~residing~~ **OR HIS OR HER EIGHTEENTH**  
8 **BIRTHDAY IF THE CHILD TURNS AGE 14 ON OR AFTER DECEMBER 1, 2007 OR**  
9 **IS AGE 14 BEFORE THAT DATE AND ENTERS GRADE 9 IN 2008 OR LATER, WHO**  
10 **RESIDES** in the school district ~~shall be deemed~~ **AND WHO MEETS 1 OR**

1 **MORE OF THE FOLLOWING IS CONSIDERED A** juvenile disorderly ~~persons~~  
2 **PERSON** and in the judgment of the proper school authorities may be  
3 assigned to the ungraded school or department:

4 (a) ~~Class 1, habitual truants~~ **EXCEPT FOR A CHILD DESCRIBED IN**  
5 **SECTION 1561(5), A CHILD WHO IS HABITUALLY TRUANT** from the school  
6 in which ~~they are~~ **HE OR SHE IS** enrolled as ~~pupils~~ **A PUPIL**.

7 (b) ~~Class 2, children~~ **A CHILD** who, while attending school, ~~are~~  
8 **IS** incorrigibly turbulent, disobedient, and insubordinate, or who  
9 ~~are~~ **IS** immoral in conduct.

10 (c) ~~Class 3, children~~ **A CHILD** who ~~are~~ **IS** not attending school  
11 and who habitually ~~frequent~~ **FREQUENTS** streets and other public  
12 places, having no lawful business, employment, or occupation.

13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect  
14 unless House Bill No. 4030 of the 95th Legislature is enacted into  
15 law.
