## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 2. (1) A seal of a court, public officer, or corporation
  may be impressed AFFIXED IN ANY OF THE FOLLOWING WAYS:
  - (A) IMPRESSED directly upon the instrument or writing to be sealed.  $\frac{1}{1}$
  - (B) IMPRESSED upon wafer, wax, or other adhesive substance affixed thereto, TO THE INSTRUMENT OR WRITING or upon paper or other similar substance affixed thereto TO THE INSTRUMENT OR WRITING by mucilage or other AN adhesive substance.
    - (C) AFFIXED ELECTRONICALLY UPON THE INSTRUMENT OR WRITING TO
