A bill to amend 1984 PA 431, entitled "The management and budget act,"

(MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594) by adding section 229.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 229. (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 2 ISSUE DIRECTIVES TO REQUIRE ALL BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES OWNED OR
- 3 OPERATED BY A STATE AGENCY THAT ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC TO PROVIDE
- 4 FOR THE RECYCLING OF GLASS, PLASTIC, AND ALUMINUM BEVERAGE
- 5 CONTAINERS. HOWEVER, THE DIRECTIVES SHALL REQUIRE A RECYCLING
- 6 STATION ONLY IF THE STATION CAN BE PLACED IN A PRACTICAL LOCATION
- 7 WHERE THE BUILDING OR FACILITY CAN ACCOMMODATE THE STATION AND
- 8 OBTAIN RECYCLING SERVICES, AND WHERE THE BUILDING OR FACILITY WOULD
- 9 HAVE SIGNIFICANT RECYCLING ACTIVITY.
