

HOUSE BILL No. 4783

April 2, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Opsommer and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

(MCL 28.421 to 28.435) by adding section 12c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 12C. (1) A SELLER OR A FEDERALLY LICENSED FIREARMS DEALER**
2 **SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:**
3 **(A) CREATE A VISIBLE REPRESENTATION OR A BIOMETRIC RECORD OF**
4 **AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS PURCHASING A FIREARM, HAND-LOADING EQUIPMENT,**
5 **OR AMMUNITION, EXCEPT FOR A VISIBLE REPRESENTATION CREATED**

1 INCIDENTALLY TO THE ROUTINE USE OF SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS.

2 (B) LINK A VISIBLE REPRESENTATION OF A FIREARM, HAND-LOADING
3 EQUIPMENT, OR AMMUNITION TRANSACTION TO AN INDIVIDUAL, EXCEPT AT
4 THE REQUEST OF LAW ENFORCEMENT IN CONNECTION WITH AN ONGOING
5 CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION OF A SPECIFIC INDIVIDUAL OR PURSUANT TO A
6 COURT ORDER.

7 (C) ADOPT A POLICY THAT REQUIRES EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:

8 (i) THE CREATION OF AN AMMUNITION DATABASE OR REGISTRY OF
9 INDIVIDUALS PURCHASING AMMUNITION.

10 (ii) REQUIRE THE PHOTOCOPYING OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S DRIVER LICENSE
11 OR THE RECORDING OF INFORMATION OBTAINED FROM AN INDIVIDUAL'S
12 DRIVER LICENSE AS A PREREQUISITE FOR THE INDIVIDUAL'S PURCHASE OF
13 AMMUNITION.

14 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
15 MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 1 YEAR OR
16 A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.
