

HOUSE BILL No. 5038

June 3, 2009, Introduced by Rep. Ebli and referred to the Committee on Tourism, Outdoor Recreation and Natural Resources.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms and gas ejecting devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

(MCL 28.421 to 28.435) by adding section 3.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 3. A PERSON WHO, BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2010, LAWFULLY OWNED,
2 POSSESSED, CARRIED, OR TRANSPORTED A FIREARM WITH A BARREL LENGTH
3 OF 30 INCHES OR LESS AS A PISTOL PURSUANT TO A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER
4 SECTION 2 OR 5B OR PURSUANT TO AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 2 OR 5B

1 MAY CONTINUE TO LAWFULLY OWN, POSSESS, CARRY, OR TRANSPORT THAT
2 FIREARM AS A PISTOL AFTER JANUARY 1, 2010 PURSUANT TO THAT LICENSE
3 OR ANY RENEWAL OF THAT LICENSE OR PURSUANT TO THAT EXEMPTION.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January
5 1, 2010.

6 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
7 unless all of the following bills of the 95th Legislature are
8 enacted into law:
